For its return to Maputo, the WORLD PRESS PHOTO exhibition will be accompanied by the best pictures taken by Mozambican and foreign photographers on the theme of religion and beliefs in Mozambique and the rest of Africa. In order to give the newest echoe to this specific theme, constantly evolving and shaping the African society, we are looking for the best photographs taken in 2018 that will showcase the impact of the different religions and beliefs on the African continent. Selected on the base of skills, reflection of the theme and shown passion for photography, the winning pictures will receive a financial reward or a Canon camera. Both winning pictures and runner ups will be showcased next to the WORLD PRESS PHOTO exhibition in Maputo between November 22 to December 13 this year and in Groningen, The Netherlands, in 2019.

This contest is to promote artistic diversity and journalistic expression through the use of photography, and to find new talents, young and/or emerging photographers. The contest is open to all enthusiasts, experienced professionals, students, masters or enlightened amateurs.

#### Theme

Religion and Beliefs in Mozambique and the rest of Africa.

#### Rules:

- No age limit.
- A maximum of three images, black and white or color, digital or film (scanned) images can be sent.
- File type should be: profile sRGB or Adobe RGB, jpg, with 186 x 110 cm, minimum resolution of 300dpi.
- The images should preferably be taken in 2018.
- Between November 1st and 11th, the best photographs will be selected, and their authors will be awarded at the inauguration of the World Press Photo Exhibition, on November 22nd.
- Winners will be informed by phone or email.
- Participants must submit their photographs to the email: contact@photocontestmozambique2018.com, together with the following information: full name, photo title, concept of the photograph (maximum 100 words), date and place where the photograph was taken and camera used.

## - Restricted to:

- 1) Persons who have Mozambican nationality (living in Mozambique or elsewhere in the world, with a proof of their identity).
- 2) Any foreigner living in Mozambique, with a proof of their residence.

# Copyrights & Usage Rights:

Copyright of the images will remain at all times with the photographer. Images will be used strictly in connection to the awards and will not be used for any other marketing purposes. Images will not be resold or used by any other third party. If there is a request for such, we will forward that request to the photographer via e-mail.
